



## Guidelines for Standard (Peer-reviewed) Paper Presentations

### **General Information**

Sessions will be approximately one and a half hours long. Presenters will have ten minutes to present their abstract with five minutes for questions and answers. There are multiple abstracts being presented in each session. This session format is common in many major scientific meetings. Please note that the room moderators will be asked to enforce these times.

### **Audiovisual & Powerpoints**

All presentation rooms will be equipped with a microphone, LCD (PowerPoint) projector, and laptop computer. No other audiovisual equipment will be available. You may use visual aids for your paper presentation however it is not required. **You do NOT have to submit your presentation in advance.** Please save your PowerPoint presentation to a flash drive and be prepared to load it onto the laptop in your assigned presentation room at least 15 minutes before your session is scheduled to begin (if you need assistance the ENRS Staff at the Registration Desk will be happy to help you). Please plan to arrive to your session room a few minutes early to make contact with your session moderator and the other presenters in your Paper Session.
